Short Term/Urgent

Items are not ranked in any priority order and are recognized as equally important to the Trustees.

- 3. Finalize transition negotiation with Sheridan College
- 4. Expand legislative involvement
- 5. Campus Master Planning
- 6. Compensation/Compensation Study

Long Term

Items are not ranked in any priority order and are recognized as equally important to the Trustees.

- 1. Partnerships across the Gillette Community College Service district and with other postsecondary institutions of higher learning.
- 2. Visibility of the college within the larger community which may include designing micro credentials for workforce development programs, community, cultural, and continuing education programs, and other programming that brings people into our community.
- 3. Expand Marketing/Public Relations/PIO which will allow Gillette College to tell their story.
- 4. Design and develop two Baccalaureate of Applied Science degrees that serve not only our local industry but address the transformational nature of our state and country.
- 5. Develop Board Governance Documents.
