Distinguished Alumni Award - Bradley Cundy

Bradley Cundy graduated from Campbell County High School in 1977 and pursued a degree in electrical engineering at Casper College from 1977-1979. However, he decided to move back home to Gillette to co-found Cundy Asphalt with his wife in 1980. After selling the company in 1999, Bradley enrolled at Gillette College and graduated with an associate degree in 2004. He is currently the CEO of Keyhole Technologies, LLC, and a partner of Cundy.Biz LLP. He is also a member of Associated General Contractorss of Wyoming, past president, and a member of the Casper Rotary Club and Gillette Rotary Club. Bradley has received several honors, including the AGC of America Build America Award in 1999 and the Boys & Girls Club of Central Wyoming Mick & Susie McMurry Try Award in 2021.



Commencement Address - Dr. Sandy Caldwell

Dr. Sandy Caldwell has a wealth of experience in the field of higher education. She worked as a community college faculty member and held various administrative positions before retiring as the Executive Director and State Higher Education Executive Officer (SHEEO) for the Wyoming Community College Commission. Dr. Caldwell has served as president of Reedley College in Reedley, CA, community college vice president at Western Wyoming Community College, in Rock Springs, WY, and community college academic leader and faculty member at Paris Junior College in Paris, TX, among other roles. She is a champion for industry partnerships and the role of governing boards and collaboration at the state-level. Dr. Caldwell has conducted numerous national presentations and has written articles for various higher education publications. Additionally, she served on numerous accreditation teams for the Higher Learning Commission and Accrediting Commission for Community and Junior Colleges.

Ceremonial Mace

The Academic Mace symbolizes the college's governing authority and signifies official proceedings. The Academic Mace is only present when the President is in attendance and is seen only at Convocation and Commencement. The Mace represents the significant responsibility entrusted to our faculty and staff to guide and direct the learning of our students. The Mace also serves as a reminder to our students that the learning process may not always be easy or comfortable, but - absolutely attainable.

Anatomy of the mace:

- Made from maple wood and silver
- Bottom: the bottom of the mace signifies the creation of GCCD and the growth of the college
- Bottom Ridges: moving up the mace signifies GCCD sharing the mission of the college for the students, faculty, staff, and community
- Middle: at the middle of the mace GCCD shares the vision of the college
- Top Ridges: these ridges symbolize the values of the college in which the students enter
- Upper Circle: the upper circle holds two medallions and represent the faculty and staff; these medallions have the GCCD logo and seal etched into silver
- Top: the top brings the mace to an end; this points to the future of all involved at GCCD students, faculty, staff, and community
