Applying for Housing

When you are ready to apply for Housing at Gillette College, please follow these steps:

- 1. Complete the Gillette College On-Campus Housing Interest Form-

- 3. When completing the application, make sure to submit the \$200.00 housing deposit (\$150 is refundable pending proper checkout and contract fulfillment) either within the application or directly to the Gillette College Business Office.
